The area surrounding Krakow is a cultural landscape of extraordinary natural and historical resources, attractive to tourists, and offering ideal conditions for relaxation in the bounty of nature or participating in sports. It is a landscape as varied as our diverse offering for visitors. One can take time out to play golf in Paczółtowice or dive in the crystal clear waters of the Zakrzówek reservoir, near the Twardowski Cliffs, where the legendary mage who sold his soul to the devil was to have maintained his laboratory in the sixteenth century. The Podkrakowskie Valleys are also a must-see – a lovely area of limestone ravines and Jurassic cliffs in unusual formations with numerous caves – which provides lovers of climbing and spelunking an opportunity to test their strength and skills. There will also be time to learn about the prehistory of these lands in the Wierzchowska cavern, the largest in the Krakow Jurassic region, and to chew the fat with a *Neolithic* man.

Aside from the captivating beauty of nature, our guests will encounter antique fortifications along the "Trail of Eagles' Nests" including a Renaissance estate in Pieskowa Skała and the ruins of a gothic castle in Ojców. There they will savour hunters' cooking and take on knightly deeds, shooting bows and crossbows, or they might just soak in the beauty of the scenery. And, should one prefer bicycle expeditions, we welcome them to the Niepołomice Primeval Forest, where they can ride the wooded trails to a bison preserve.

The Four Elements: Extreme adventure at a Quarry near Krakow



We invite lovers of excitement and adventure to visit Krakow's nearby Zakrzówek neighbourhood, on a reservoir of crystal clear water surrounded by rocky cliffs, known as the Twardowski Rocks. As legend holds, centuries ago one of these grottoes was where the famed medieval magus Master Twardowski practiced his mystical arts. Participants in the event will experience extreme adventure while relaxing in the bounty of nature. They will explore the secrets of scuba diving under the supervision of professional divers. They will feel the excitement of discovery, diving to a depth of 21 meters

among the wrecks of old cars and boats. Underwater they will find a granite tablet commemorating Karol Wojtyła, later to become the Holy Father John Paul II, who worked here as a labourer during the Second World War. Participants will also experience Alpine adventure in the surrounding rocks, repelling over a precipice in a harness or crossing rope bridges. They can then explore the Twardowski Cave where to this day, the whispers of incantations uttered by the great magician can still be heard. The participants will receive a "pact" as a memento of their visit to the wizard's lair and then, after a day of excitement on the Zakrzówek reservoir, they will take part in a party and concert by well-known stars of the Polish music

be heard, along with tales of the history and the natural resources of this area. The group will meet a knight from the nearby castle, who will show them around the ruins of Oiców's fortresses and invite them to share in the hunter's bounty - traditional Polish bigos (hunter's stew) and delicacies from the grill. Then there will be an opportunity to try one's skills with the bow, accuracy at horseshoe throwing and stilt walking. After the feast we will take the participants to "Little Wawel", the castle at Pieskowa Skała where over a glass of wine the curator will tell them of the tales of the historic Renaissance estate and show the most stunning views of the surrounding area. Visit to the Cave of Łokietek and bicycle rides on the National Park grounds are optional.



We finish off the event with a joint party in the "Under the Hanging Rock" hall, with a summary of the activities on the obstacle course and the presentation of a participation certificate.



If one wants to find the soul of Poland, let them seek it in Krakow... Krakow – the once seat of Kings, the place of coronations of Polish monarchs is a city whose history is the very identity of Poland, and the great, thousand -year-old heritage of the national culture. Nowhere else will you find so many jewels of Polish history and culture, or such a concentration of so many historic buildings and traces of the lives of exceptional people of learning and the arts. Krakow is the city of the oldest Polish university, of Copernicus, and of the Holy Father John Paul II. Here, under Wawel Hill, we find the largest set of historic monuments in Poland, comprising over six thousand priceless architectural treasures, and also the largest national art collection housed in the city's museums and churches. It is to this that we invite you! The darkness of the Middle Ages is illuminated by a knightly feast at the foot of a fourteenth-century Castle, where the guests learn courtly dances and a minter

presents them with half-grosz coins with the visage of Władysław Jagiełło. They will also uncover the secrets of extracting salt from the underground veins of the world's only mine of its kind that has been active since the Middle Ages – the Wieliczka Salt Mine. And for those who are inspired by the Art Nouveau works in the Church of St Mary and the Gothic basilica of the Franciscan fathers, we invite you to a game of copying a painting made by one of the acclaimed creators of the Young Poland era. The artists of the legendary cabaret "Under the Sign of the Rams" will lead our guests deeper into the artistic ambiance of Krakow, and their sketches and songs will be as "tasty" as the delicacies of Galician cuisine in one of the city's elegant restaurants.

Art Nouveau in Krakow – Painting Workshops



We invite you to take part in an original artistic undertaking, preceded by a visit to the Krakow Stained Glass Museum, where the standards of the craft have been guarded for a century. Here you will be able to see over 800 stained glass artworks by the most renowned Polish artist of the early twentieth century, such as Stanisław Wyspiański, Józef Mehoffer and Karol Frycz. Next, in the Gothic Franciscan

cathedral, participants can admire the collection of stained glass by Wyspiański, whose designs were created in a Krakow stained-glass workshop. In one of the city's museums: the Mehoffer House, the Palace of the Arts, or the Wyspiański Museum, a painting workshop will be conducted for our participants, preceded by a lecture on Krakow's Art Nouveau works. Then will come the time to discover your own talents, use your imagination and creativity, and to feel the atmosphere of the city, try your hand at pouring your own vision in to the canvass.

Wieliczka Salt Mine – Special VIP Tour



We invite you to visit Wieliczka, the medieval *Magnus Sal*, containing a salt mine with an over 700-years-long history, visited by masses of tourists from everywhere in the world, listed in the first UNESCO List of World Natural and Cultural Heritage Sites, and operating continuously from the Middle Ages to today. On the road to the mine our guests watch a video of the most lovely of the miners' festivals on the coach monitors and listen to a concert played by the mine orchestra. They are led through the depths

of the mine to the high, beautiful chamber of Michałowice by a miner-guide, who will explain the history of the mine and its geological features.
