

Krakow and Samarkand - possible cooperation

The Embassy of the Republic of Uzbekistan in Warsaw initiated the first official visit of Mr. Ikrom Nazarov - the Embassy's Charge d'Affaires - in Krakow

On 13th June (Monday) Mr. Nazarov visited the Mayor of the City of Krakow. The meeting was held in order to make first contact which in future might develop into multi-layered cooperation between the cities.
