

## Voting in the Civic Budget (BO)– what do you need to know?

### **Where can I find projects that have qualified for the voting stage?**

Their list can be found at the [budzet.krakow.pl](http://budzet.krakow.pl).

### **How can I vote?**

Voting will be carried out on the Internet - via a dedicated platform available during the voting period at [budzet.krakow.pl](http://budzet.krakow.pl) and traditionally – at polling stations organised throughout the city.

### **How do I know where the polling station in my city district is?**

Visit the website [budzet.krakow.pl](http://budzet.krakow.pl), where you will find a full list of polling stations and their opening hours

### **Who can vote?**

Every resident of Kraków, regardless of age. BO is also for children and young people.

### **Can I vote online first and then at a polling station?**

No, you must decide. You can vote only once, either at a polling station or online.

### **How do I vote?**

Select 3 citywide and 3 district projects each. Rate them on a scale of 1 to 3 points, where 3 corresponds to the task you think is most deserving of implementation. The projects which receive the most points will be placed on the ranking list.

### **What happens to my vote if I indicate less than 6 projects - 3 each for the districts and 3 each for the city?**

Do not do it this way, because your vote will be invalid.

### **Which tasks will be implemented?**

The ideas that receive the highest scores will be selected for implementation until the funds allocated for the civic budget are exhausted (both on a city-wide and district scale).

### **What details do I need to provide when voting in the traditional way?**

When voting at the polling station, you must provide your name and surname, address of residence, a PESEL number/identification code assigned by the Kraków City Hall for those who do not have PESEL number and the district number according to your address. Remember to bring your ID with you.

### **How to vote online?**

First, register on the platform by providing your name and surname, address of residence, a PESEL number or, for those who do not have it, date of birth and gender, mobile phone number and the number and name of the district according to your address. Voting via the platform involves confirming the creation of an account via SMS.

**Do I have to sign up every year?**

No, once created, the account is active. You can also use it when submitting applications to the Civic Budget.

**Have your data, address, email address or phone number changed?**

You can correct them after logging in using the previous data with which the account was set up (e.g., email address). After logging in, click on "Update data" in the left-hand menu.

**What happens if several projects score the same number of points?**

Then the order on the ranking list will be decided by public draw.

**What if the next project on the list exceeds the funds allocated for BO on the district or city scales?**

In such a case, the first of the following projects whose implementation will not cause the available funds to be exceeded will be considered.

**I live in Bieżanów, but I work in Zwierzyniec and I would like to vote for a project from this district. May I?**

No, we vote only for projects from the district we live in.

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**Civic Budget. How to vote?****1. Choice of voting method**

In person by means of a ballot paper in designated places

Electronically via the internet platform [www.budzet.krakow.pl](http://www.budzet.krakow.pl)

**2. Selection of projects**

We select three citywide projects and three district projects.

**3. Awarding points**

We indicate a total of 6 projects and award 3 points, 2 points and 1 point

3 points for the project supported the most

1 point for the project supported the least

**4. Completing your data**

Fill in your personal details. You can vote only once.

Your vote will count.
